



DRESS CODE

Ulverston Golf Club aims to operate a dress policy which reflects current golfing trends and ensures members, guests and visitors maintain a clean, tidy and smart appearance.

ON THE COURSE & PUTTING GREEN

It is expected that Members, Guests and Visitors maintain an acceptable tidy appearance on the Course and all of the designated the practice areas. Normal golf wear (recognising changing fashions) available from the Professional's shop or any golf wear outlets represents the standard of clothing and footwear acceptable to the Club Management Board.

- Proper golf shoes must be worn by golfers and their caddies.
- Tailored shorts of appropriate length may be worn with knee length or suitable sports socks.
- Track suits, football type shirts and beachwear are not permitted.
- Members must not tuck their trousers inside their socks regardless of conditions unless they are wearing suitable waterproof over trousers which mask their socks and trousers.

Members and other persons not complying with these dress standards may be asked by Club Employees and / or Club Officials to leave the Course and may only return when they are fully compliant with the dress code.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE & DRIVING RANGE

Members, guests, visitors and staff should at all times wear clean, neat, smart casual clothing and footwear whilst in the clubhouse lounge areas.

- No caps, visors or golf shoes should be worn in any of the Clubhouse lounge areas.
- Tailored shorts of appropriate good length may be worn but for men should be accompanied by suitable sports socks.
- Members, Guests, Visitors and Staff should at all times wear clean, neat, smart casual or fashionable clothing and footwear whilst in the Clubhouse lounge areas. It is recognised that dress codes cannot reasonably prescribe for the vast range of clothing and footwear available to all. However, the Club expects everyone to display common sense by ensuring that their attire does not cause offence or embarrassment to others using the Clubhouse.

The Club Management team reserves the right to advise those using the lounges that their attire is inappropriate and in such event the matter will be referred to the Club Manager-Secretary at the earliest possible opportunity so that if necessary, action can be taken to prevent any reoccurrence.

Published Club organised Social events will indicate the dress code required on any advertising literature.

Members, guests and visitors not complying with these dress rules may be asked either to change or to leave the Club premises or course by any official, member or member of staff of Ulverston Golf Club.
