



Supplementary Card Protocols Under Covid-19 Restrictions

The process for returning supplementary cards is as follows:

Sign-In

Players must indicate their intention to return a supplementary score PRIOR to teeing off.

- The player must send an email to handc@ulverstongolf.co.uk
- Set email subject to 'Sign-in for Supplementary Score - *Player Name*'
- Specify the date and time of your tee time.

Scoring

Players will mark their own card.

- Play from the yellow tees (men), red tees (ladies)
- The player must write their own scores in the Player A column
- Player must sign their card on the Player's Signature line.
- Once the marker has verbally indicated that he/she agrees with the player's score the player must PRINT the name of their marker on the Marker's Signature line.
- The marker must be someone who has an official handicap.

Returning Score

In order to minimise risk to H&C competition organisers from handling cards players must return their cards electronically.

- After checking and signing the card the player or someone in their household must use a phone to photograph the card (make sure it is clear and captured in full)
- The scorecard image should be emailed to handc@ulverstongolf.co.uk
- Set email subject to 'Supplementary Scorecard - *Player Name*'
- Players should retain their card in case the email goes astray.

Additional Information

- Players in handicap categories 2 to 6 may return as many supplementary scores as they wish.
- Category 1 players may not return supplementary scores before 1st September and only then in order to return 3 qualifying scores for the year.
- Rounds can be played over 9 or 18 holes (if 9 holes it must be the front 9).
